

East Cascades Audubon Society Data Distribution and Sharing Policy

Adopted August 6, 2013 by the ECAS Board

To the extent appropriate, all original data and map products produced by the East Cascades Audubon Society (ECAS) shall be made readily available to the broader conservation community to facilitate the educational, research, and conservation purposes consistent with the Mission of ECAS. For effective distribution, ECAS may employ cloud-based platforms, such as eBird, DataBasin, Oregon Explorer and/or the Conservation Registry.

Certain circumstances may require limitations on distribution. Examples of circumstances that may warrant restrictions on distribution of data might include nest locations for sensitive species or situations where an original author or data source has imposed such limitations. This information will be contained in the file metadata, and it is the responsibility of the user to understand and adhere to these policies.

Those desiring to use ECAS data or maps for commercial development or personal gain must obtain expressed, written permission from ECAS for the use of this information. Use of this information in *any* form of publication including print and online should give credit for the data or map with the following disclaimer:
